

RAYLEIGH REMEMBERS.....

The Annual Service of Remembrance and Wreath Laying in Rayleigh will be held on Remembrance Sunday, 12th November 2017.

There will be the usual Parade through the Town Centre, forming up in Websters Way Car Park at 9.30 am and marching off at 9.40 am. The salute will be taken at the High Street/Bellingham Lane junction, before the parade reaches Holy Trinity Church, Rayleigh. There will then be a Service in the Church commencing at 10.15 am, with a concurrent Service in the Church Parish Hall at the same time. A third shorter service will also be held in front of the Royal British Legion Memorial Hall, London Hill, Rayleigh, which will start at 10.40 am.

When all the services are ended at 11.15 am and all are assembled, there will be a Wreath Laying Service at the Royal British Legion Memorial Hall War Memorial.



It has been seen in previous years how important this day is for so many in Rayleigh, when those of the Town come together in Remembrance of all those who have given so much for us today.
