In the current economic climate, Rayleigh Town Council realises that any increase in the council tax bills will be unwelcome. The Council has worked hard to keep the town council's precept as low as possible. The council have absorbed many price increases such as the cost of utilities and suppliers suffering high inflation and increases in national insurance contributions for staff, by using some of the council reserves.

As a result, there is an increase for Rayleigh Town Council element on your council tax bill. The average band D household will only pay £15.74 more a year, a total of £54.18 per annum (£1.05 per week) for Rayleigh Town. This amount remains one of the very lowest of the 13 Parishes of Rochford District.

Having recently taken over responsibility for the John Fisher playing field from Rochford District Council, Rayleigh Town Council have also had to make additional financial provision for the maintenance and upkeep of this open space and play area. Equally, we are committed to providing the very well-supported community projects such as Trinity Fair, Christmas lights, floral displays and supporting the remembrance parade to name a few, together with supporting and encouraging lots more community projects in the future.
